Are you ready?

- 1. Have you read the letter about returning to school? This can be found on the school website in the online learning section under each year group or in the Coronavirus Information section of the website.
- 2. Do you know the name of your child's **new** teacher? This information can be found in the letter on the website.
- 3. Do you know the name of your child's **new** class? This information can be found in the letter on the website.
- 4. Do you know which entrance to use when you drop your child off in the morning? This information can be found in the letter on the website.
- 5. Remember to keep a safe distance from other parents and children.
- 6. Send your child to school on time between 8.35-8.45 a.m.
- 7. Collect your child on time 2.45 a.m. /11.20 11.30 in nursery.
- Your child must wash their hands when they arrive in school and after every activity. They will have to wash their hands for at least 20 seconds. They will also be using hand sanitisers frequently please talk to them about our expectations.
- 9. If you choose to send your child to school with a mask this must be removed and placed in a plastic bag provided by the school for safe keeping. Please note, staff cannot be responsible for reminding your child to replace or remove their mask – Government guidance currently states that children under 11 are not required to wear a mask.
- 10. We would like children to wear uniform whenever possible, this can be purchased online on www.brigade.uk.com/index.php . We would ask that you send your child to school in fresh clothes every day and we understand this means there may be some days when they need to wear their own clothes.
- 11. Your child will need to bring a named water bottle to school everyday
- 12. Please remember to bring your book bag in to school every day and a pencil case (if you are in Key Stage 2)
- 13. Please empty school bags everyday checking for letters that have been sent by the school.
- 14.Staff may need to wear PPE if your child needs first aid. Please make sure your child is aware of this.

- 15. If your child shows symptoms of Coronavirus while at school, you will be contacted and we will explain what you will need to do.
- 16.It is **vital** that we have your up to date contact details. We are required by law to have a minimum of two telephone numbers for each child. We also expect parents to provide us with an up to date email account. We have struggled over this lockdown period to get information and vouchers to parents who have not updated their addresses.
- 17.We will work with you if your child is distressed when they need to come in to school. Please understand if staff cannot hold them we may ask you to take them home again. If this happens, we will contact you the same day to look at how we can support you.
