<b>Can you do something about the parking outside school?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Informed the community police.</li> <li>• Informed the local M.P.</li> <li>• Liaised with Bordesley Neighbourhood Team Local police team.</li> <li>• Send out important information about parking outside our school to all parents.</li> </ul>
<b>I want to know what my child has for lunch every day.</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Make sure an up to date menu is on display in the main reception foyer.</li> <li>• Make sure an up to date menu is available to view on the school's website.</li> </ul>
<b>I find it difficult to pay for school trips</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Those children qualifying for pupil premium funding will get their school visits paid for with this money.</li> <li>• Parents will be supported by the school to establish if they qualify for pupil premium funding</li> <li>• Parents will be given the option to pay for school trips in instalments if this is more convenient</li> </ul>
<b>I live far away from the school</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide support to check if parents qualify for a free or subsidised travel bus pass</li> </ul>
<b>I have issues around safeguarding</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Parents will be given support or sign posted to the relevant agency</li> <li>• Parents will receive information regarding e.g. E Safety</li> <li>• Parents will be invited to the School's Community Day where they are able to access a wide range of support</li> </ul>
<b>I want to go to college</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Parents are supported by providing visits to local colleges</li> <li>• Parents will be invited to the School's Community Day where they are able to access support</li> </ul>
<b>I need to talk to someone about my child's health.</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The school will arrange an appointment with the school nurse or</li> </ul>
<b>I need to get into school quickly</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Risk assessed additional gate opened to meet needs of nursery parents and children</li> </ul>
<b>I haven't got enough money</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Those parents with no recourse to public funds are signposted by DSL to relevant agency eg food bank</li> </ul>
<b>I can't help my child with her maths homework</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide maths workshops for every year group in school in order for parents to support children with their learning.</li> </ul>
<b>What are the SATs?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All Y2 parents are given the opportunity to attend a session where they are given information about the forthcoming SATs test and how they can support their child.</li> </ul>
<b>What is TFW?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Whole school initiative of Talk for Writing introduced to Y1 parents as a workshop in order to support storytelling and writing at home.</li> </ul>
