Literacy

How to help your child at home:

How to help your child at home:

How to help at home:

- To explore food

How to help your child at home:

- Talk about foods we eat - how do we make it, where it comes from, what it tastes, feels and looks like?

Physical Development

- Learn about how to put a coat on and off.

How to help your child at home:

- Encourage your child to dress and undress independently.

Expressive Arts & Design

- Use different media to create.

How to help at home:

- Ask your child to use old food boxes to make things with.
