














 <p>Class: Reception</p> <p>Home Projects for Autumn Term 1</p>	<p>If you would like to explore some of your learning from this half term at home, have a go at completing some of the activities below. We would love for you to bring anything you make or do into Reception to share with the rest of your class!</p>
<p>Communication and Language</p> 	 <p>This half term we will be thinking about how we have changed since we were babies. Talk to your child about what they were like as a baby. Do you have any photos or baby items you could share with them?</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	 <p>We will be thinking about birthdays and celebrations. Can your child find out how old the different members of their family are and have a go at witing the numbers?</p> <p>Sing along with some of these counting songs! Have a go at some of these counting games! Watch Numberblocks!</p>
<p>Physical Development</p> 	 <p>Encourage your child to be independent by putting on and taking off their own coat, including managing</p>
<p>Knowledge and understanding the World</p> 	 <p>Look out for signs of Autumn and talk about the changes at home. What is happening to the trees? What colours are the leaves? At the park, collect some fallen leaves, conkers, or pinecones. Can you sort and count them?</p>
<p>PSED</p> 	 <p>We have made lots of new friends since starting school and we are learning how to play and share together. Could your child make a card to give to one of their new friends?</p>
<p>Expressive Art and Design</p> 	 <p>Who lives in your house? Could your child draw a picture of your family?</p>
<p>Literacy</p> 	 <p>This half term we will be focusing on writing our names. Encourage your child to practise forming the letters from their names in foam, dough, 'in the air' and with a pencil.</p>
<p>Reading</p> 	<p>Children will be learning phonics through our 'Little Wandle' scheme in school. Soon your child will receive a login to our 'Big Cat' website where they will be able to access the book that they have been practising reading in school. More details to follow shortly...</p>
