Lesson 1 focus: Rare GPCs (/ɪ/ sound) [Phonics- Day 1](#)

Show children a range of images from the resource and ask them to say what they can see. They will have seen some in the previous lesson on 'y' making /ɪ/. Get children to sound out the words and write them down. What do they notice? They should see that there are some more unusual ways of making the /ɪ/ sound. Any words that are not learnt should be carried over to an extra session the next day
