Communication and Language






Our new topic is Animals! Talk to your child about their favourite animal. Can they name and describe animals? Do they know what they eat and where they live? Which animals are from England and which animals are from different countries?

Maths





Find out which animals your family likes! Which animal is the most popular? How many people like each animal? Help your child to make a bar chart to show their results.

It's Winter! Can your child put on their own coat and do the zip? We are practising in Reception. Does your child know how to do buttons and zips? Have a practise! Don't forget to bring hats, scarves and gloves to school everyday and ensure your child has good footwear as we spend lots of time outdoors.
