

Year 2 Summer Term
What will we learn this term?

English

Magnificent Monarchs: Our English work this term is linked to our History project, Magnificent Monarchs. We will read, explore and write Information leaflets, Kennings poems and comic strips.

Maths

Fractions: We will learn to recognise, find, name and write fractions of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity.

Time: We will learn to tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past and quarter to the hour. We will draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.

Volume: We will learn to choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure capacity using measuring vessels. We will also compare and order volume and record the results using $>$, $<$ and $=$.

Science

Animal Survival: In this project we learn about growth in animals by exploring the life cycles of some familiar animals. The children build on learning about the survival of humans by identifying the basic needs of animals for survival, including food, water, air and shelter.

Computing

Computing System Networks And Technology Around Us

Learners will develop their understanding of technology and how it can help them in their everyday lives. They will start to become familiar with the different components of a computer by developing their keyboard and mouse skills. Learners will also consider how to use technology responsibly.

Creating Digital Media - Digital Painting

Learners will develop their understanding of a range of tools used for digital painting. They then use these tools to create their own digital paintings, while gaining inspiration from a range of artists' work. The unit concludes with learners considering their preferences when painting with and without the use of digital devices.

History

Magnificent Monarchs: This project teaches children about the English and British monarchy from AD 871 to the present day. Using timelines, information about royal palaces, portraits and other historical sources, they build up an understanding of the monarchs and then research six of the most significant sovereigns.

Art

Portraits and Poses: This project teaches children about portraiture. They analyse the portraits of Tudor monarchs and compare Tudor portraits and selfies today. They use photo editing software to create royal portraits.

Design Technology

Cut, Stitch and Join: This project teaches children about fabric home products and the significant British brand Cath Kidston. They learn about sewing patterns and using a running stitch and embellishments before making a sewn bag tag.
