

St. Benedict's December Recommended Reads



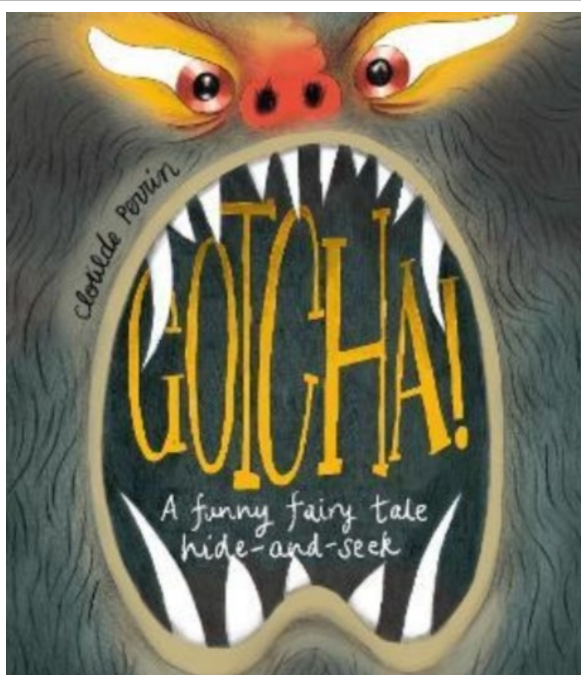
Reception

The second book in a brilliant new series of 'pick your own' picture book adventures!

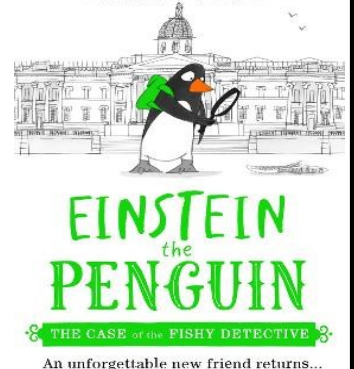
Do you love dinosaurs? How about robots? And unicorns? Find them ALL in the pages of this laugh-out-loud interactive adventure!

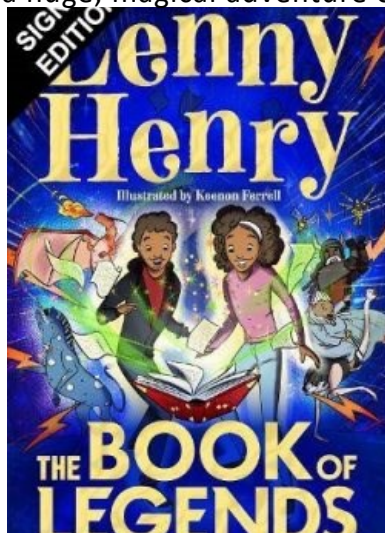
