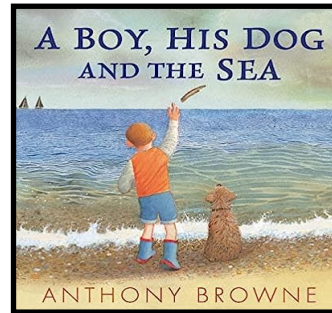

Joe loves wild animals and nature, but he lives in the city where it feels like there is no wildness to be found.

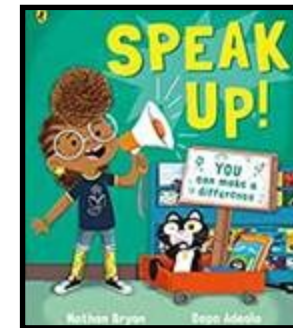


Year 1 & 2
