This means that school will be open for only some pupils e.g. if your child has additional needs or for working parents. If you are celebrating Eid, then your child is not expected in school on this day. I will write to all parents on Monday 2nd June to confirm arrangements.

On **Monday 9th June**, <u>all</u> children will be expected back in school. We will have a more relaxed start to the day to allow all families to get into school.

Trips

To make it easier for parents this year, we split trip payments into 3×10^{-1} x instalments of £6.50 per child: total £19.50 (£5 in Reception, total £15).

By now, all parents should have made two payments for trips: £ 13 for Y1-6 and £10 for Reception. This is excellent value for money! It also makes budgeting easier.

As well as a 'big trip' each year, all classes go on other local trips and children in Year 4 and 5 go swimming. All year groups have enjoyed a trip to the Eco Park, plus other local trips, such as to RBC or sports events.

If you have not paid any money yet, then do ensure you do so, or speak to the office staff if there is a problem.
