
A Safeguarding Message — Children should be wearing seat belts and using appropriate car seats when travelling in cars.

THE LAW ON SEAT BELTS:


- Drivers are responsible for ensuring that they and any passengers under the age of 14 are wearing seat belts.
- Passengers aged 14 and over are responsible for wearing their own seat belts.
- Children must also use an appropriate child car seat until they are 12 years old or 135 cm tall, whichever comes first.

World Book Day
















Yesterday, we had an amazing World Book Day. The children had lots of fun reading and writing book reviews about books that represent them.
