Children are also invited to prepare work to be on display, bringing it to school by 5th March. There will be prizes for the best entries.

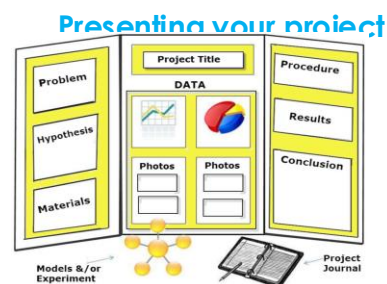
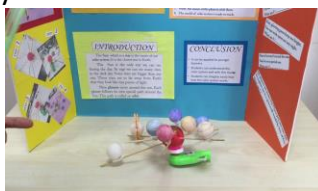
Science Exhibition
