Active Uniform

Last week asked parents, staff and children for their views on an Active Uniform. Most of the school is in favour of trying this out.

Children can now choose to wear an ACTIVE uniform every day to school.

If they prefer, pupils can still wear their normal school uniform.

What is an ACTIVE uniform?

- **Black trainers**
- Black (or grey) jogging bottoms, or PE shorts
- Red T shirt
- Red jumper or fleece
- Red hijab/sports hijab for PE



Children must not wear:

- Coloured or white trainers
- Logos/branded clothing e.g. football shirts
- Hooded jumpers
