All money raised will be spent on our children.

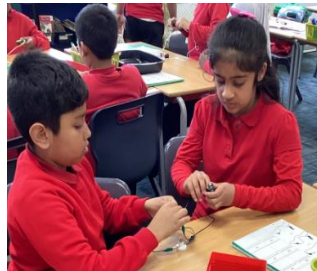
Parents, please **arrive at school at 1:45pm**, ready to collect your children at 2pm and to take them to the Mela. **All children must be collected for 2pm.**
