Attendance

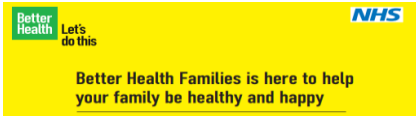
This week's whole school attendance is **92%**

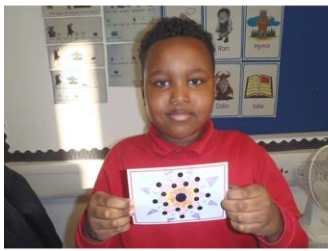
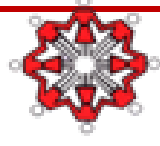
Every child deserves a warm welcome!
