How to help your child at home:

Encourage your child to mark-make for pleasure. Can they make shopping lists, dinner menus and packing lists? Encourage them to have a go at reading and writing simple words and sentences.

Personal Social & Emotional

Theme: Celebrating Differences

- Know what being unique means
- Know the names of some emotions such as happy, sad, frightened, angry
- Know why having friends is important
- Know some qualities of a positive friendship
- Know that they don't have to be 'the same as' to be a friend

How to help your child at home:

Talk to your child about how they are special.

Maths

- Building numbers over 10
- Counting beyond 10
- Spatial Reasoning 1
- Adding more
- Taking away
- Spatial reasoning 2

How to help your child at home:

- Help your child to deepen their knowledge of numbers over 10. Count your steps on the way home.
- Help your child to develop early addition and subtraction by presenting simple real-life problems.
 E.g. '6 of us are having dinner. I put 4 plates out, how many more do we need?'

Communication & Language

- Talking about houses and homes
- Developing topic-based vocabulary types of houses, types of furniture, houses around the world, materials, animal habitats, food and where it comes from, recycling.

How to help at home:

Talk to your child about different types of houses. Notice houses on your journey to school and discuss the features.

Understanding the World

- How do Muslims celebrate Fid?
- What is inside of a Mosque?
- Are all houses the same?
- Where do animals live?
- Where does food come from?
- What are houses made of?
- What were houses like long ago?

How to help your child at home:

Visit the library or research on the internet to find out more about houses around the world and homes from history.

Physical Development

- cutting skills/ fine motor activities
- Penpals: curly caterpillar letters: c, a, d, o, s, g, q, e, f
- PE
- Climbing frame

How to help your child at home:

Practise forming all curly caterpillar lettersc, a, d, o, s, g, q, e, f
