	a consonant letter, so is	
	added straight on to most	
	root words.	
	• If the root word ends in	
	consonant letter 'y', the 'y'	
	is changed to 'i', but only	
	if the word is more than	
	one syllable.	
	• If the root words ends in	
	'le', the 'le' is changed to	
	'ly'	
	If the root word ends with	
	'ic', then '-ally' is added	
	rather than just '-ly'	
	(exception: publicly).
