



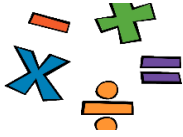

Use the matrix, concentrating on the words ending in '-le' and '-ic'. Read the words and add '-ly' to each. Discuss how they might be written down. This will be practised in the next lesson.
