Task 1 Science

Identify whether an animal is a carnivore, herbivore or omnivore and how we might know this from their physical appearance. Sort a collection of animals into groups according to the type of food they eat. Record your ideas with drawings and labels.

Task 2 Art

Use a range of different drawing materials to create pictures of popular pets from memory and from photographs provided. Draw the animal's shape and outline, capturing recognisable features such as ears, tails, teeth and paws. Explain what they have drawn to an adult, identifying the animal's special feature.

Task 3 Handwriting

Handwriting is an important skill that children need to learn. In Year 1, we are currently practising joining letters. However, this is only possible if children can correctly form their lower case letters. This week I would like to you practise recapping and practising forming the lower case letters. These can be found in Year 1 under the handwriting section. Please practise handwriting daily.
