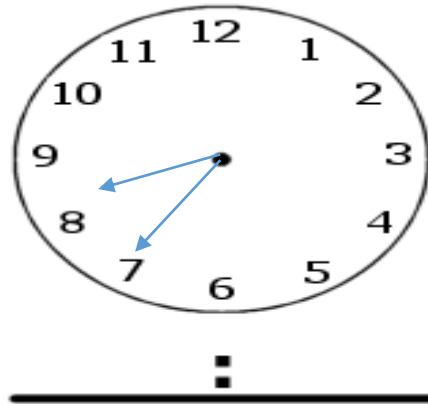
## When will my child start school?

- Children will be starting in their new class on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September 2021 from 8.35 am until 11.30 a.m. This will continue on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> September 2021.
- On Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> September children will stay for lunch in school until 12.30.
- On Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2021 and Friday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2021 **most** children can stay for the whole day from 8.35 am until 2.45 pm and have their lunch in school. They will attend on a full time basis from this time onwards.
- There may be some variation to dates dependent on how your child settles into reception.

School starts at 8.35am

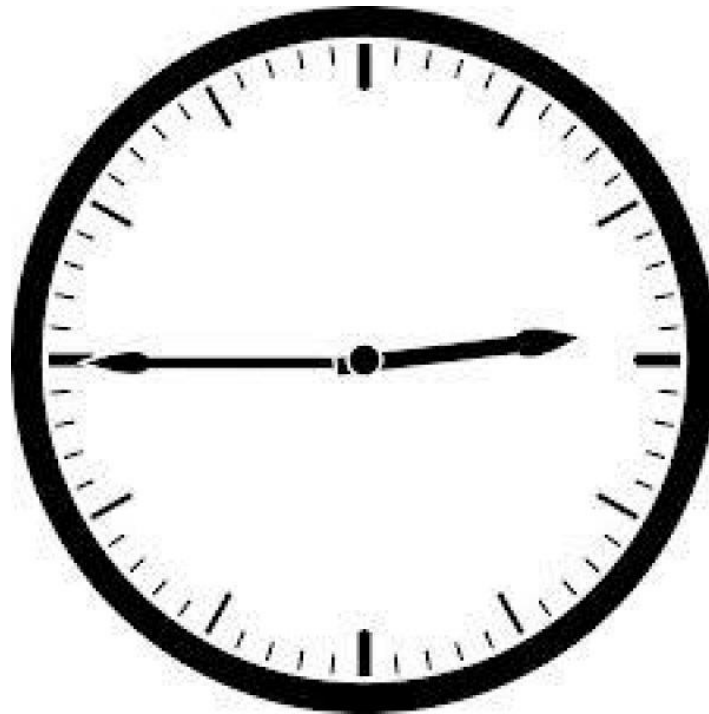


Please make sure that your child is in school on time.

We finish school at 2.45pm.



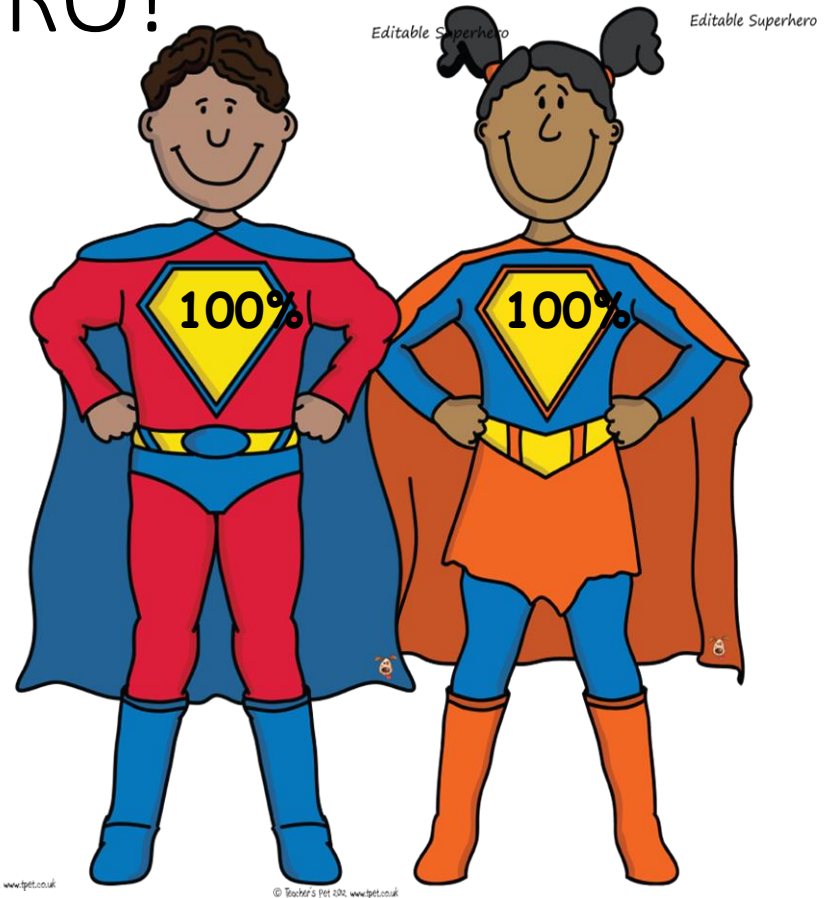
Please make sure that you collect your child on time at the end of the school day.

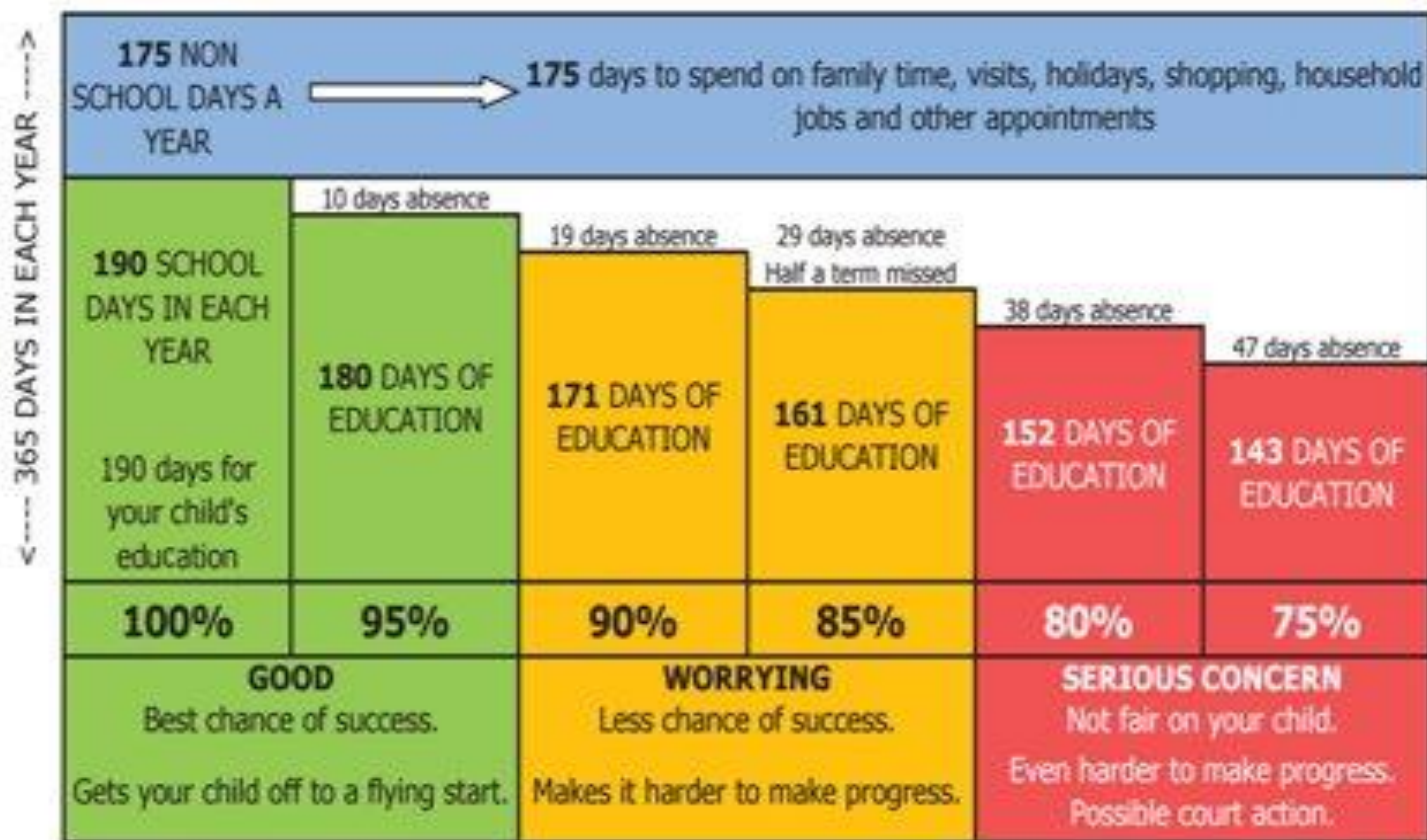


Please make sure that your child comes to school everyday. Time out of school adds up to lost learning. Phone school to let us know if you child is too unwell to come to school.



## ATTENDANCE

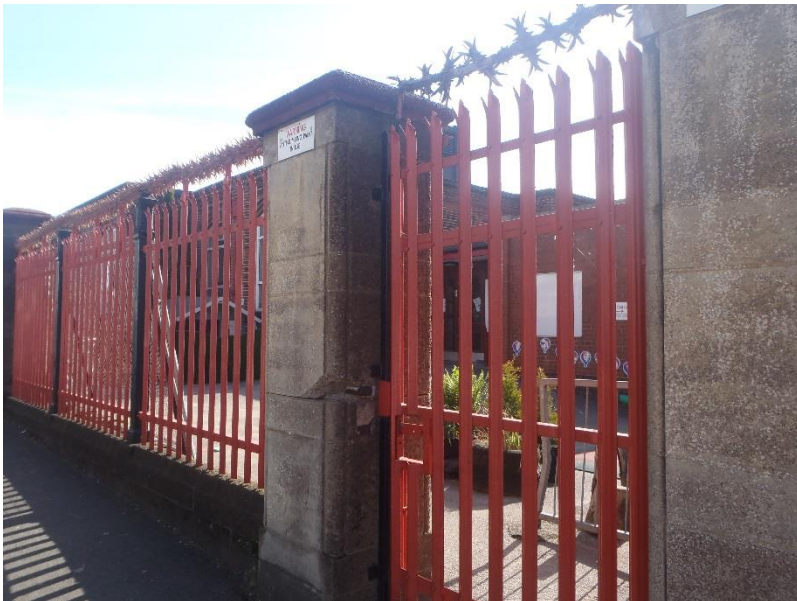
We expect children to come to school every day. Time off school means lost learning time. Please see the chart below.

# School Dinners

# Milk and Fruit Time



Children will be given a drink of milk or water and a piece of fruit, this can be accessed throughout the day.

# School Uniform



- Boys will need to wear a red polo shirt, a red sweatshirt and grey trousers.
- Girls will need to wear a red polo shirt with grey skirt or pinafore dress or trousers with a red sweatshirt over the top. They can also wear a red or white headscarf if you so wish.
