Dear Parents,

We hope you are all well and we wanted to let you know how much we are looking forward to your return next week on 3<sup>rd</sup> September (or on the 7<sup>th</sup> September for new Nursery and Reception children).

PLEASE ENSURE YOU HAVE READ YOUR CHILD'S LETTER ON THE WEBSITE – YOU MUST USE THE CORRECT ENTRANCE AND ARRIVE ON TIME. (Letters are in the out of school work section) The letters also detail the steps we have taken to keep everyone safe.

The measures we have in place are to keep your children safe and must be adhered to. We thank you in advance for your cooperation – it will take a few days to get used to, but please be assured we have carefully planned access to school. We will let you know as soon as possible if any changes need to be made.

You will be aware that the Government often change their guidance. They are currently advising that Secondary aged children should be wearing masks in school. Whilst this does not apply to children of Primary age, it is your choice as to whether you want to send your child in one. Please note, it is your responsibility to teach your child how to take it off and put it on securely – we will have bags in school for them to be stored in. Staff cannot responsible for ensuring your child is wearing it or not; as the guidance clearly states it is not necessary for young children to wear them.

One last reminder – it is vitally important that parents ensure they are socially distancing when bringing and collecting their children. As there will be numbers of you around the school, I would strongly urge all of you to wear face coverings whenever possible. We need to work together to keep us all safe and this is one of the best measures for adults.
