Our school has signed up to receive **free healthy breakfast food** for our children as part of the Covid response offer, under the National School Breakfast Programme (NSBP), which is being delivered by the charities Family Action and Magic Breakfast.

This free breakfast food is available for the Autumn and Spring Terms in school.

As part of this government funded programme, schools can choose to offer children a healthy breakfast at school or at home. Our plan is to offer breakfast packs which will be available for children to take home until things are settled at school and the current restrictions are eased or lifted. Children will receive these packs every fortnight to take home. The packs will include pre packed bagels and cereals.
