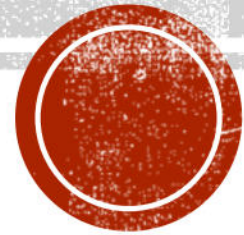


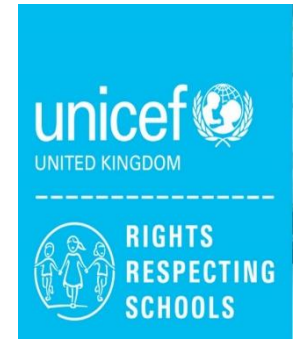

RIGHTS RESPECTING SCHOOL



Article 12

You have the right to give your opinion and for adults to listen and take it seriously.

YEAR 4 MULTIPLICATION TABLE CHECK

- In 2021-22 every school in England will administer an online multiplication tables check to all Year 4 pupils.
- It will be a short online test to make sure that pupils multiplication tables knowledge is at the expected level.

“Leaving primary school with a fundamental grasp of basic numeracy is as important as leaving being able to read. And just as the phonics check has helped more children learn to read, this will ensure more pupils know their times tables.”

- The national curriculum specifies that pupils should be taught to recall the multiplication tables up to and including 12×12 by the end of Year 4.
- The purpose of the MTC is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for the future success in mathematics.
- It will help schools to identify pupils not yet mastered their times tables, so that support can be provided.



TEST

- Pupils will be asked to answer 25 questions on times tables from 2 to 12.
- They will be given 6 seconds per question with 3 seconds rest between each question, so the test will last less than 5 minutes.
- The questions that will most likely be asked will be on 6/7/8/9/12 times tables, which are often the most hardest to learn.



PROGRESSION THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL

- Year 1 – Count in multiples of 2/5/10
- Year 2 – Able to remember and use multiplication and division facts for 2/5/10 times tables including odd and even numbers.
- Year 3 – Able to remember and use multiplication and division facts for 3/4/8 times tables including odd and even numbers.
- Year 4 - Able to remember and use multiplication and division facts for all times tables up to 12 x 12.
- Year 5 – Revision of all multiplication and division facts for tables including 12 x 12.
- Year 6 - Revision of all multiplication and division facts for tables including 12 x 12.
